"Partnering Schools" with Hong Kong LifeRoad Theological Seminary (HKLTS)

Since HKLTS was officially established in Hong Kong in 2016, God has enabled us to partner with a number of leading schools around the world. Through the partnership MOUs with each of these schools, we have seen the value of a mission-oriented school and equipping pastors and church leaders with theological education in the mission field.

In the case of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary (SWBTS), we signed an MOU in 2016 with the Church Music Department of HKLTS and the Life Road Singers (LRS), the exclusive praise group of HKLTS. Since then, we have already conducted a certificate program for the faculty of the Church Music Department, and next summer 2025, a group of SWBTS' faculties will conduct a certificate program for all the students of the Church Music Department of HKLTS.

The Master's Seminary (TMS), located in Los Angeles, is the seminary of Dr. John MacArthur, the pastor of Grace Community Church (GCC), a leading Reformed conservative church in the United States, and our seminary visited and shared ministries there back in 2020. As a result of the partnership, TMS provided us with a significant amount of video lectures for our online courses at no cost. TMS Seminary has been an invaluable outlet for us to provide quality theological education to pastors on the mission field.



In addition, Virginia Christian University (VACU) has granted HKLTS students a dual degree program, and Moody Theological Seminary (MTS) in Chicago has agreed to allow HKLTS students to participate in online courses on MTS's website at no cost and to issue certificates of church leadership upon completion. As part of the MOU, we agreed to participate in mission conferences at each other's schools to share our ministries.

In November of this year, another MOU will be signed with Malaysia Baptist Theological Seminary (MBTS) in Malaysia. MBTS is one of the few prestigious seminaries in Southeast Asia, and this November, our staff will participate in their 70th anniversary service & commencement, followed by the MOU signing ceremony with HKLTS.

We are very grateful to God for these partnerships with these prestigious seminaries overseas, and we believe that through these partnerships, HKLTS will work even harder in providing "sound theology" to pastors and church leaders in the mission field that we serve.


We are also continuing to interview new students for the September semester.




Sxxx Campus News!

Sxxx Campus has completed the final exams for two of the four courses that began in March: Systematic Theology and Ecclesiology, Discipleship, Missions and Cultural Anthropology, and The Gospel of Mark.

Mission and Cultural Anthropology and Gospel of Mark are still in progress, (with 8 students and 4 taking the class as guests,) for a total of 12 students. Not only are the students growing and being transformed by the good quality of teaching of the professors, but they are also sharing abundant grace with many questions and lively discussions after each lecture.

Thank God for the opportunity to establish sound theology and build up good ministers for the local leaderships here.

Update from our CxxDxx campus!

Currently, the Master of Arts in Worship program, which opened in September last year, four worship leader training courses, one worship leader training course in cooperation with local churches, and two Sunday school teacher training courses are in progress. In the case of the worship leader training course, there are many people from other regions outside of CxxDxx who are interested in the course, so discussions are underway to open the course remotely in other regions as an integrated online/offline course.

In June, three teachers from Life Road Singers Korea visited CxxDxx and gave vocal lessons to the students of the worship studies course and Sunday school teacher training course, which were well received.

By 8 July, all spring semester courses were completed.

By the end of June, we had finished our 'beginner' and 'advanced' classes, and on the morning of 4 July, we held the beginner and advanced classes' graduation ceremony. Two students from the beginner class and another two from advanced calss graduated.

It was a very emotional and honourable time as it was the culmination of a year or two of study.

The Bachelor of Christian Education classes are almost finished with the final exams and the Bible exam on 8 July. There are still 12 book reviews for students to complete before the end of July and a final week of intensive classes in the third week of August for graduation.

The seniors are working on a number of personal preparations for the graduation ceremony taking place on 1 September at our HK main campus.

News from our Central Asia Campus!

The Central Asia region is home to a huge variety of ministries. Above all, our most important work here in Central Asia, the LifeRoad Seminary ministry, is going well. About 20 students from Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, and Tajikistan have done well in the Introduction to the Old Testament (April), Romans (May), and Christian Counselling (June) classes. We are now compiling and distributing the overall grades for the first half of the year to the students, and we will be having graduation ceremony early next year (our fourth graduation). More than 80% of the students are already pastoring local churches in the field, and the rest are also ready to serve in any forms. We look forward to seeing many groups established and strengthened here in Central Asia through these precious students.

- 1) For the Lord's amazing grace on the students during their special summer ministry.
- 2) For God's grace for "the early church history" class in September, "the missiology" class in October, and the field trip to Korea scheduled for the end of September.



Malawi Campus Update!

Our campus in Malawi, Africa, opened in September last year and is currently running as a hybrid, using a combination of Zoom, video, and on-site classes to deliver the required courses. The 3rd batch students are taking programs with us now, and the 4th batch (another 40 students) class will begin in September. They are taking either B.A. in Biblical Studies, Master of Divinity, or M.A. in Christian Education program with us, and we are preparing to offer a combined Th.M/Ph.D. program in the second half of next year. As we are teaching the classes each semester, we are witnessing these local pastors who are really sincerely engaged in each course... They are being prepared to serve the local churches with sound theology on the ground in Africa.

Prayer requests:

- 1) There will be a ZOOM class and on-site class in September and December respectively. Pray for the preparation of the professors who will be teaching the classes. There are local pastors who have limited access to electricity and internet networks, making it difficult for them to participate in online and ZOOM classes. Pray for the helping hands and co-operation.
- 2) Pray for Pastor Lewis, who is serving as the student director in Malawi, that he will be well established as the leader there, and pray for wisdom for the Hong Kong team who are setting up the classes each month.



Southeast Asia (Laos and Philippines) Campus Update!

The Southeast Asia campus has not officially started yet, but will begin in September this year at the request of local pastors in Laos and missionaries from the Philippines.

Currently, about 15 local pastors and missionaries have submitted applications and are preparing to take classes. The administrative set-up is complete and the classes will be taught in English, so we are expecting more applicants from local pastors in Southeast Asia, including Filipino missionaries in the diaspora. Through a Filipino businessman and missionary himself (Mr. Jun) who owns a hotel in the area in Lao, we have received requests from local pastors and missionaries to begin theological education in the area, and we are very excited that classes will begin in September.

Prayer requests:

- 1) We are in the process of recruiting additional professors who can teach classes in English. Please pray for the availability of professors with a missionary heart.
- 2) That God will send precious students (local pastors and missionaries) who will be educated in sound theology and will serve the church in various ways.





"Life Load Singers" (LRS) Update!

By the grace of the Lord, Life Load Singers returned to Korea in February from the U.S. tour and are continuing the ministry. The mission of sharing the gospel through praise is being fulfilled by dedicated members who calle themselves as 'praise ministers', and there has been an amazing and precious grace of the younger generation of members being dedicated and growing as part of the team. We hope and pray that LRS ministry will continue to be passed down from generation to generation, and that more members with classical music backgrounds will come together to sing.

In the meantime, LRS has been sharing the grace of worship with many other Christians in person through visiting many different churches. And through monthly music recordings, we have been sharing our refined and pure choral praise with more people. In particular, since May, we have been recording not only Korean but also English and Chinese songs, further clarifying our identity as a 'mission worship team' and expanding the audience with whom we share our praise. Only by God's grace have we walked this path, and we hope to continue to walk the path of life together in worship.

- 1) That many souls will come to know Jesus through the praise of LRS, and that souls will be restored and healed
- 2) For God to expand the reach of LRS' evangelistic outreach through praise, for the recruitment of younger singers, and for continued financial supporters
- 3) That in a rapidly changing world and culture, LRS will remain steadfast and fulfill the mission for which we are called.
